Policy/Code:	TEC, §21.0032 (a-1)				
Summary:	TEC, §21.0032 (a-1), authorizes the commissioner of education to approve district requests to delay implementation of certification requirements for foundation curriculum courses until the beginning of the 2029-2030 school year. The application must include an evaluation of how the district will transition to certification during the extension, and will require a district to: <ul style="list-style-type: none">Identify the total number of uncertified individuals currently assigned to teach foundation curriculum courses (by subject area and grade level);Indicate the total number of new, uncertified teachers hired on average each of the last three years;Identify at least one Educator Preparation Program partner who will be used to support certification efforts during the extension;Obtain approval from the district board of trustees to delay teacher certification requirements until the beginning of the 2029-2030 school year; andInclude confirmation of the board of trustees' approval with the application submission to the commissioner of education.
