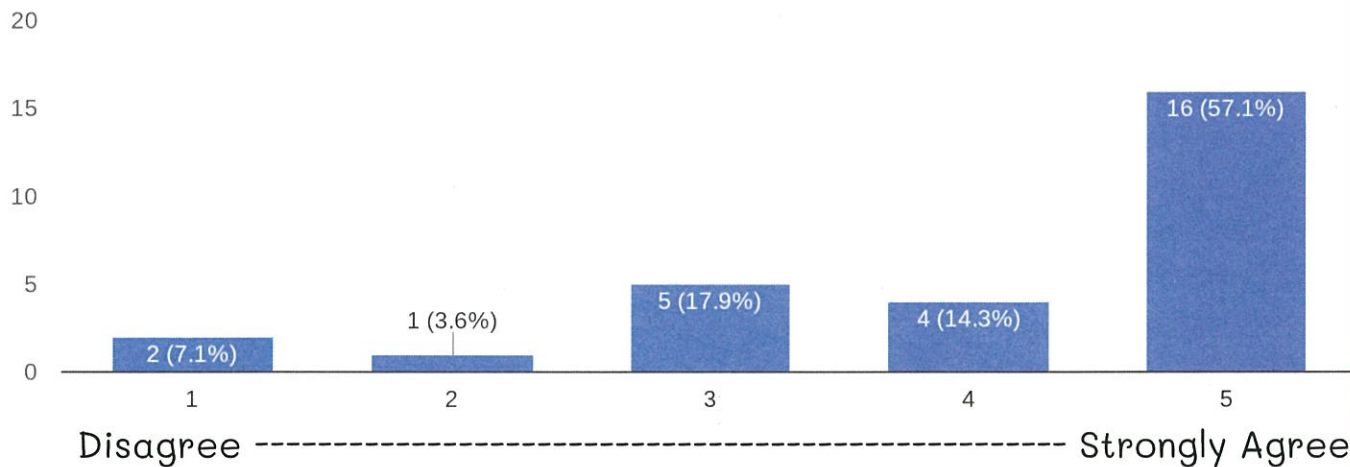

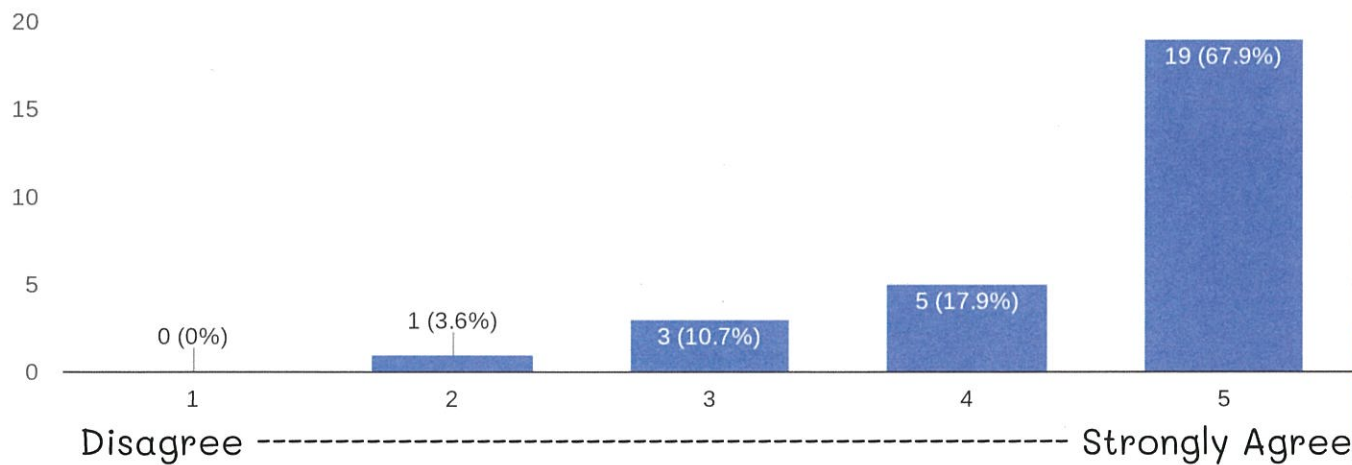

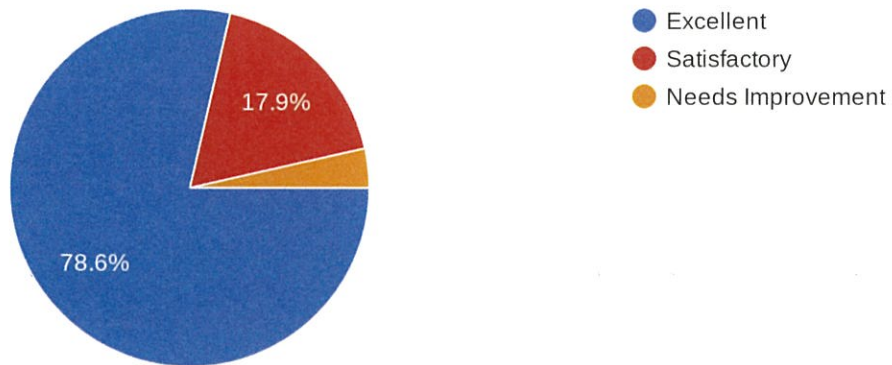


Parent's were overwhelmingly very happy with the social interaction this allowed their students.

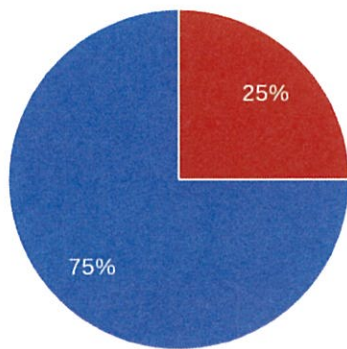


Feedback: Wished there had been busing. Also hoped for more challenging material
