

1. Educational Purpose & Learning Outcomes

The International Thespian Society, an honors organization for high school theatre students, proposes a field trip to the **Stratford Festival in Stratford, Ontario, Canada**, from **June 27–29**. This trip supports the development of students' artistic, analytical, and collaborative skills by providing exposure to world-class professional theatre and interactive performance training.

During the trip, students will attend **three professionally staged productions**—Anne of Green Gables, Dirty Rotten Scoundrels, and Macbeth—as well as participate in a **hands-on performance workshop** led by industry professionals. These experiences are aligned with our

performing arts curriculum and support state and national theatre standards, particularly in the areas of:

- Theatre Appreciation and Criticism: Students will analyze and reflect on acting techniques, directorial choices, staging, and production design across a variety of genres and styles—from classic Shakespearean tragedy to modern musical theatre.
- Performance Skills and Technique: The workshop provides direct instruction in acting, movement, or vocal performance, deepening students' practical theatre training beyond the classroom.
- Cultural and Historical Understanding: Through Macbeth and Anne of Green Gables, students will explore key literary works and historical contexts, making interdisciplinary connections with English Language Arts and Social Studies.
- Professional Exposure and Career Awareness: Experiencing live productions
 performed by accomplished artists gives students insight into potential careers in theatre
 and the performing arts, while modeling professional-level expectations and artistic
 excellence.



The Stratford Festival is internationally recognized for its artistic quality and educational programming. This trip offers a rare and meaningful opportunity for students to engage deeply with their craft in a safe, structured, and culturally rich environment. 
