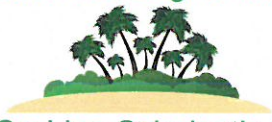

Here are a few suggestions to help make our Family Book Fest a success:

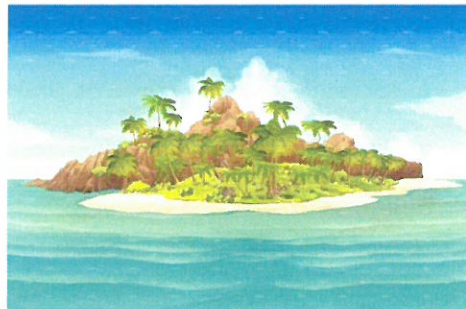
- Set aside a specific **time** to gather the family together for each day's 15-20 minute reading.
- Set aside a specific **place** to read as a family.
- Older students are welcome to share in the reading aloud. Take turns!
- After reading each day's selection, take a few minutes to discuss questions for each chapter (questions will be included with the books, along with a special bookmark).
- If you miss a day's reading, don't worry. Weekend days have been set aside as "make-up" days.

Each student at The Fort will receive a copy of *Nim's Island*. Funds for the purchase of the books were made possible through a grant from Fort Vannoy's PTO.

We trust that you will find the Family Book Fest a positive experience for you and your family.

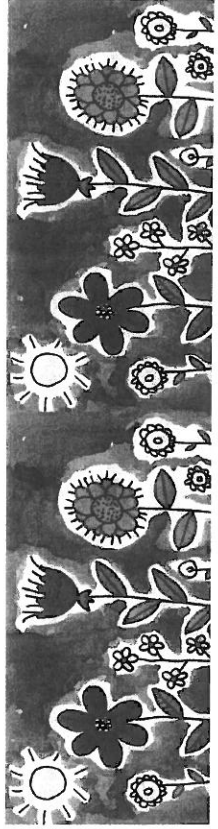
