**DESCRIPTION:**

Community Education (CE) continues to offer quality enrichment and remedial experiences for families and children in the summer. We also offer the referral-only Targeted Services program.

CE is going into its 4th year of the Summer Sun Block program. Centralized bussing will be offered from the District elementary schools. Classes will be held Monday through Thursday, 8:30-11:30 a.m. at BCMS from June 17-Aug. 1. We will offer classes such as, Chinese, Sign Language, Poetry, Nature Art, Body works and more. As you will see in the attachments, there is a wide variety of classes for students grades K-7.

We will again be offering a referral-only remedial reading and math program using Targeted Services funding. This program will be offered free of charge to children entering grades 1-6 who are referred by their classroom teacher. It will be offered during the Sun Block sessions. Students who qualify for targeted services may also choose classes in Sun Block free of charge and can use the centralized transportation.

CE continues to offer:

- Summer camps - such as Arts Magnet, Mock Trial, recreation
- Middle School 101 - for students entering middle school next year
- Swimming Lessons
- Red Cross Baby Sitting
- Sports Camps - tennis, football, basketball, volleyball and more
- SPARK - if funding supports
- Kid Kare - locations at DES and NES
- Little Kid Kare
- ECFE classes
- ECFE in the Parks

For adults, we continue to offer a full range of programming as well.
