
## **INSTRUCTIONAL BENCHMARK DATA:**











**KINDERGARTEN REGISTRATION:** There were only 46 student pre-register for Kindergarten this year. We know the numbers are down statewide, so we are interested to see how many more register in August.

BIKES FOR BOOKS: Silver City Masonic Lodge #13 donated four (4) bikes to be given away to students who read books between March 3<sup>rd</sup> and May 14th. Each student had to read 10 books to be able to earn a ticket for the drawing. They could read as many books as they wanted to earn tickets. The 1<sup>st</sup> grade students read 2,420 books, up from 1,690 books last year. The 2<sup>nd</sup> grade students read 650 books, up from 380 books last year. The 3<sup>rd</sup> grade students read 470 books, up from last year's 400 books, and 4<sup>th</sup> grade read 1,820, down a bit from last year's 2,040 books. This year the students read 5,360 books compared to last year's total of 4,510 books. The students read 850 more books even though the competition was two weeks shorter and we had a 4-day week as well! The winners were Juanita Hernandez, Tanner Carver, Lizzy Egusquiza, and Brayden Volkers. They were so excited!



<u>VOLUNTEER TEA:</u> A celebration was held on May 13<sup>th</sup> in the library for parents and community members who volunteered in our school during the year. Some were mentors, some helped in the classroom, some helped with events, some were PTO members, and others helped with walking club. We sent out 62 invitations and we had seven (7) volunteers attend the celebration. We appreciate the volunteers giving so generously of their time.
