Re: A proposal to purchase of a new patrol vehicles for the police department

### Purpose

I am writing to propose a solution to a problem in the South San Antonio Independent School District Police Department Patrol fleet. The current patrol vehicle fleet is very old and most of the patrol vehicles on the fleet are considered unsafe due to high mileage and many years of service. My recommendation is to develop a strategy to maintain a safe and serviceable patrol fleet over time. I hope that you will approve this proposal and submit it to the school board for approval. The purchase of two new patrol cars will improve the overall safety and operations of the police department and lower liability to the South San Antonio Independent School District with providing school safe environment for all it serves.

#### The Problem with Current System


Currently, the patrol fleet is very old and has not been managed properly over the years. The problem with not replacing patrol vehicles on a regular basis is the liability to the school district increases because the patrol vehicle constant use makes it unsafe after many years of service. Plus, older vehicles require frequent repairs in which repair cost also rise. In the 2012-2013 police budget, \$3,800 was designated to vehicle maintenance; however; by January 2013 a budget adjust needed to be made to cover the amount designated in the original budget due to the high repair cost this past year. An estimated cost in repair of patrol vehicles this past school year was approximately 11,000. Two of the patrol cars transmission went out of service for an extended time reducing our patrol fleet. In November 2011, a district officer was injured in a patrol vehicle accident responding to an alarm call causing injury to the employee and the vehicle is still unserviceable. Officer reported the brakes failed.

Another problem not having a well maintained patrol vehicle fleet is the liability to the school district. Patrol cars are used for various task needed to provide a safe and drug free environment. Older cars are considered unsafe after many years of service. Patrol vehicles are used to transport officers, staff, students and criminals. The school district has the responsibility to provide a safe form of transportation. Police cars are different than personal cars because many patrol cars are used on a daily basis 24/7 and they also obtain many idle hours which causes depreciation faster than personal own vehicles. Some agencies replace their patrol cars at 100,000 miles. Below is a spread sheet that reflects the South San Antonio ISD Police Department patrol vehicles high mileage and years of service.

The chart shows how many patrol cars with high mileage


#### A Solution to the Problem


