

Progress notes

- Fountain plumbing and concrete demolition complete.
- Temporary Cougar statues relocated to front of RAD Center.
- Underground utilities cut and capped.
- Landscape demolition around the fountain complete.
- Site demolition, underground utilities and fountain repairs in progress.

Progress notes

- Exterior construction fencing and wayfinding signage installed.
- Demolition of interior concrete lanes and existing landscaping complete.
- Guard Kiosk has been removed.
- Underground utilities demolition and coordination in progress

- Storm water / irrigation lines installed.
- · Fountain base and vault installed.
- Site grading and concrete work in progress.
- Electrical conduits and light pole base installation in progress.
- Pedestrian access routes in progress.


