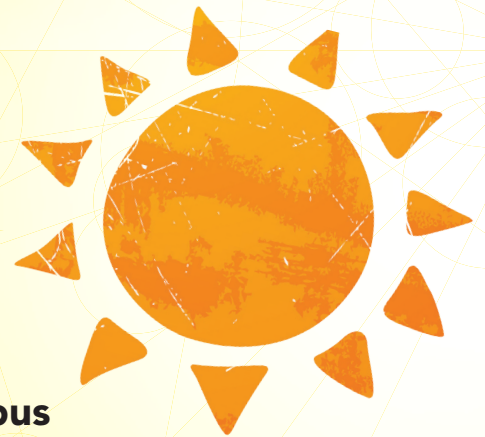

EMP-199 Intro to Emergency Management – 2 credits

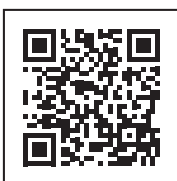
CYBERSECURITY
