Dear Superintendent's Leadership Council,

Attached is the Spring Trip request for the Odessa High School Band and Orchestra for a trip in June of 2018 to Walt Disney World in Orlando, Florida to perform for a workshop and enjoy a variety of other activities. Our goal here at Odessa High School is to provide our students with unique opportunities that might not otherwise be available to them. This trip will be musically and culturally rewarding for the students in our program and helps us reach for this goal.

Musically, the students will be participating in the Walt Disney's You're Instrumental workshop, providing an exclusive behind the scenes look at what it would be like to work as a professional studio musician. Our groups will examine the skills, attitudes and priorities essential to musical excellence and culminate with a very special finale: a recording of our ensembles performing Disney music accompanied by footage from a classic Disney animated film! Musicians will learn proven rehearsal and performance-enhancing techniques from a top Disney clinician as they:

- Incorporate accuracy and expressiveness to maximize rehearsal productivity.
- Emphasize intonation, balance and tone quality and follow the conductor's interpretation.
- Discuss the requirements of a studio-recording environment and what is expected of performers.

Walt Disney World is a magical place that not many students will get to travel to outside of this opportunity. Employees at Disney parks wear name badges that include the location of their hometown. Those from another country often write "hello" in their native language and teach the park guests how to say it. Among the park attractions that offer educational opportunities are the Hall of Presidents, the Carousel of Progress, the Kilimanjaro Safari and the Wilderness Explorers.

We have scheduled the trip after the end of the school year so that students will not be missing classes in order to travel. This scheduling also gets rid of the problems with eligibility, as all students become eligible following the last day of school. At this point, we do not know how many students will choose to participate, but if history holds, we will take approximately 180 students and 20 chaperones. Preliminary cost projections are \$2,000 per participant, though at this early date, all prices are subject to change. Attached is a preliminary schedule for the trip and a preliminary list of fundraisers that provided to help fund this activity. As stated above, our goal is to provide the students in Band and Orchestra opportunities that many of them would not get outside of these organizations.
