Description: South San Antonio ISD Middle School Students participated in the IDRA Youth Leadership Now Program Statewide Reflection Contest where they submitted a painting, essay or poem on how YLN have impacted their lives.

Historical Data: Coca Cola/ VYP/ YLN partner for 40 years. The IDRA Youth Leadership Program is an in-school program for eighth-grade students in San Antonio and West Texas that combines three winning strategies: IDRA's Valued Youth Partnership with middle schoolers deemed high-need become tutors of elementary students; teacher mentoring to prepare for high school; and IDRA's family leadership model, Education CAFE, by engaging families and tutors in youth action research projects for their school community. The teacher mentors also participate in a professional learning community to impact the wider campus. This field-initiated, research-based program is funded by the U.S. Department of Education.

Recommendation: Recognize Youth Leadership Students from Dwight, Zamora, and Shepard Middle Schools who won prizes in the IDRA Youth Leadership Program statewide reflection contest.
