Beanstack

Beanstack Basics

1. Students and staff can access Beanstack through the Links on the district website, their campus Library Google Classroom, a mobile app, or create a shortcut on their laptop.
2. Students login using their student id as their username and their birthdate as their password in the following format MMDDYY
3. Staff login using their email as their username and the phrase: beanstackreads as the password.



Beanstack 6 week Challenges

1. Students will participate in challenges that occur every six weeks.
2. They log their minutes read and complete book reviews and other activities to earn badges and rewards from the library.
3. Beanstack activities are fully integrated with Google and other interactive apps.
4. Teachers can log minutes read as a whole for their class.

There are 15 total badges for them to earn at increments of 200 minutes.

Year Long Challenge Continued

- The librarians will give out the prizes for new badges earned in the year long challenge every 3 weeks following the dates below:
 - October 1
 - October 22
 - November 12
 - December 3
 - January 7
 - January 28
 - February 18
 - March 11
 - April 1
 - April 22
 - May 13

Students will also receive a certificate for each logging badge they earn.

Superintendent Super Readers Club

- Students have the chance to be a part of the Superintendent Super Readers Club every six weeks.
- Students need to earn 500 minutes read each six weeks to be a part of this group.
- Students who earn this will receive a t-shirt and attend lunch with Dr. Moreno.
 - Tentative lunch weeks
 - 1st six weeks= 9/27-10/1
 - 2nd six weeks= 11/8-11/12
 - 3rd six weeks= 1/4-1/7
 - 4th six weeks= 2/22-2/25
 - 5th six weeks= 4/11-4/14
 - 6th six weeks= 5/16-5/20

Other Beanstack Promotions

- Each Friday the campus librarians will make an announcement of each grade level's top readers.
- The 15 badges in the year-long challenge will be made poster size and hung around the school. As students complete a badge, their name will be posted with the badge on the school wall.
- The books students have written reviews for will be printed out (the cover image of the book) along with the student's review and hung around the school to promote that book.
- Shout outs will be made on campus Facebook pages every 2 weeks for the top classroom minutes logged.
- At the end of each six weeks a trophy will be presented to the campus with the most total minutes logged for that six weeks.

Other Library Initiatives

- Fall Family Literacy Night is scheduled for Wednesday, October 27th. It will be a drive thru event in the RECHS Auditorium parking lot. This is a collaboration between the Library department and Family Involvement.
- Each campus will be scheduling family events such as “Blind Date with a Book”, “Book Swap”, “Book Character Parade”, etc....
- Holding a reading cafe once a week after school where students can independently read while drinking hot chocolate and having muffins.

Year Long Bean Stack Challenge

- Robstown Reads: Power Up with Reading
 - Robstown ISD is ready to “Power Up with Reading.” Log your reading minutes to earn badges and prizes all year long. Will you soar to new heights and use your superpowers to help your campus be the #1 readers in Robstown ISD?
- Students and staff will have from September 1 to May 6th to earn all the minutes logged badges in this challenge. Good news is that as they log minutes for the 6wks challenges it also counts towards this one.

Detailed: 6 week Challenges

- 1st six weeks- Back to School Reading Challenge (Aug 11-Sept 24)
- 2nd six weeks- Hallow-Read Around the World (Oct 4- Nov 5)
- 3rd six weeks- Read to Raise (Nov 8- Dec 17)
- 4th six weeks- Newbery & Caldecott Winners (Jan 4- Feb 18)
- 5th six weeks- Idita-Read (Feb 22- April 8)
- 6th six weeks- Spring into Reading (April 11-May 26)

Throughout each six weeks students will receive their small prizes for each logging badge they earn. The week following the end of each six weeks, the librarian will have their celebration for all the students who completed the challenge.
