

Superintendent Comments April 28, 2026

1. Pre-Sale Report or 2026A Facilities Maintenance Bond Issue  
This pertains to the bonds for the roofing projects this summer.  
This item is informational only and does not require action. A representative from Ehlers will be in attendance to answer questions.
2. Response to the Resolution of Non-Concurrence  
There are three items on the Resolution of Non-Concurrence that need to be addressed through this response. Indian Education Director Keenan Humphrey will be in attendance and present the response.
3. Grow Your Own Grant  
This is an informational item only. Director of Teaching and Learning, Emily Seefeldt will explain the two Grow Your Own Grants that the district will be able to access over the next five years. One of the grants is for a student pathway and the other is for an adult pathway. The total between the two grants is \$1,250,000 over five years.
4. Approve 2027-28 School Calendar  
The calendar committee met several times and arrived at this proposal for the calendar. **I recommend a motion to approve the calendar as presented.** Emily Seefeldt will present the calendar.
5. Amend 2026-27 School Calendar  
This calendar has been amended before, but another conflict was identified that requires an adjustment. **I recommend a motion to approve the amendments to the calendar as presented.** Emily Seefeldt will present the changes.
6. Licensed Teacher Non-Renewals  
There are four licensed probationary teachers who are being recommended for non-renewal of their contracts for next year. I recommend a motion to approve the non-renewals. The name and positions are as follows
  - Kristine Rodger - High School Special Education
  - Darcy Bock - High School Special Education
  - Lauren Runze - Elementary
  - Dani Dewitt - High School DAPE and Physical Education
7. Tower View Lease  
**I recommend a motion to approve the lease with the Anderson Center for the Tower View ALC.** The Anderson Center is in the process of remodeling the space the school district uses for the Tower View ALC. The remodel includes additional space and creates a space that is considerably more education centered. The lease for the first year is \$97,000. While this is a substantial increase, the amount per year is quite reasonable. Also, since this space is leased, we are able to levy for the cost of the lease.
