# CONNECTED LEARNERS, CURRENTLY AND IN THE FUTURE

How many students are currently connected learners?

- Elementary 2520
- Middle School 1764

What if 25% of those students chose to remain in connected learning?

- Elementary 630 (approximately 5 sections per grade level)
- Middle School 441 (1 teacher per grade level per content area could accommodate 450 students at 30 to 1)

#### PURPOSE

- Provide an option for connected families, currently engaged and successful in the Denton ISD, who still have health concerns and prevent students from leaving district for other options.
- Reconnect with families and students who may have selected homeschool or disengaged with Denton ISD for a different form of instruction.
- Allow teachers to continue to specialize in a virtual modality of instruction.

#### TIMELINE-CURRENTLY

- Human Resources, the Business Office, and Academic Programs are discussing target numbers for students and staffing needs.
- Human Resources is developing a profile and teacher interest process for prospective Virtual Academy teachers.
- Human Resources is developing a profile for K-8 Virtual Principal and will post the position for internal candidates.

# TIMELINE-IMMEDIATE NEXT STEPS

- Communications will establish marketing and pertinent community information.
- A principal for the K-8 Virtual Academy will be named.
- The teacher profile and interest form will be released.

# TIMELINE-MARCH THRU APRIL

- Online pre-registration for students will be opened in March.
- We will request a TEA School ID. The target date is April 21.
- Board updates will be provided in February, March and April.
- Registration and commitment forms will be secured in order to finalize the master schedule.

## FEEDBACK

- We will have a formal process to gather faculty and staff feedback in the coming weeks.
- The district will post a FAQs resource on the website by the end of March.
