RESOLUTION IMPOSING 2022 WINTER PROPERTY TAX LEVY PURSUANT TO PUBLIC ACT 357 OF 2004 AND NOTICE OF CERTIFICATION OF COUNTY ALLOCATED TAX LEVY.

WHEREAS, Alpena County is authorized under the General Property Tax Act, Public Act 206 of 1893, as amended to levy and collect County allocated property taxes; and

WHEREAS, the General Property Tax Act has been amended by Public Act 357 of 2004, being MCL 211.44a.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that pursuant to Public Act 357 of 2004, the Alpena County extra voted millage rates on December 1, 2022 at a rate, allocated after application of the "Headlee" millage reduction fraction, 4.7424 mills for winter.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Treasurer of each City and Township in Alpena County is directed to account for and deliver the County allocated tax collections for 2022 in accordance with the provisions of Public Act 357 of 2004; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this Resolution constitutes certification of the levy of extra voted millage rates on December 1, 2022 at a rate, allocated after application of the "Headlee" millage reduction fraction, 4.7424 mills for winter.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the total 2022 millage rate for December 1, 2022 for Alpena County of 4.7424 mills is hereby adopted; and
