



## Multiple Modes of Instruction




At least 2 "brain breaks" or 1 brain break and 1 mobility-activity per lesson



Minimal Lecturing



Teachers have formally reviewed the strategies in these books last year, but it still remains as an outstanding resource for the staff and especially for new teachers each year.










