1.9 Policy Formulation

- Eliminates the 5% reporting requirement
- Eliminates the requirement of getting a vote of ALL licensed or classified personnel when changing policy
- Requires a vote of the appropriate Personnel Policy Committee (PPC) when changing policy
- Adds additional wording edits

1.14 Meeting Agenda

- Requires that the Board receive a report or presentation concerning student academic data and performance each month

1.17 Nepotism

- Eliminates the requirement to move an employee on the salary schedule as a result in changes or terms of conditions of the existing contract
- Eliminates wording around contract renewals

1.21 Date of Annual School Board Election

- Outlines timelines for individuals choosing to be candidates in the board elections to begin circulating of petitions and collecting of signatures 90 days prior to election dates - based on the presidential and governor elections
 - Tuesday after the second Monday in November (President)
 - March 2 (Governor)
- Outlines timelines for individuals choosing to be candidates in the board elections to file their petition, affidavit of eligibility, and political practices pledge with the county clerk during a one week filing period that closes at noon on:
 - Tuesday after the second Monday in November (President)
 - March 2 (Governor)

1.22 Recording of Board Meetings

- Eliminates the reference to employee termination or non-renewal hearings that are closed to the public verbiage

1.24 Board Representative on Education Service Cooperative Board of Directors

- New policy that:
 - Requires the Board to appoint an individual to serve a two year term on the Service Cooperative Board of Directors
