Building Updates - Work is being done to transform room 125 A into a new CAD lab that will compliment the additions to the woods and metals lab. Most of the work is being done with the custodial staff to help save on costs.

FFA Fruit Sales - The FFA fruit orders were delivered and distributed on December 16th. The fruit sales are a major fundraiser for our FFA. The group sold about 450 boxes of fruit.

Reality Store - Cheryl Hopkins is planning the Reality Store which will be held from 8-12 on January 9th. Reality Store is a simulation where students experience paying for the real world based on a salary for a career that they had explored. There will be a number of community volunteers and it is really a great experience for our students.

Holiday Concert - The High School holiday concert was held Monday, December 9th. Mr. Joosten, Mrs. Joosten, Mr. Steffen, and the students did a tremendous job.

Spirit of Christmas - The girls basketball team did their annual Spirit of Christmas drive, collecting monetary donations to provide presents for local children.
