Subject: Resolution and Interlocal Agreement with the City of Carrollton for School Resource Officers

Background Information:

- The Texas State Legislature has authorized the use of Interlocal Agreements between and among governmental bodies by and pursuant to the Interlocal Cooperation Act, Texas Government Code, Chapter 791.
- School Resource Officers have been an integral part of the security at our schools. LISD has found that these agreements have served the common public interest of both the School District and the respective cities. Both parties mutually benefit from the SRO program in order to combat juvenile delinquency, to assist students with various problems involving actual or potential involvement with law enforcement, to develop and maintain positive relations between students and city police officers and to assist the School District in maintaining a safe, orderly and a secure environment for learning.

Administrative Consideration:

- This agreement will update the Interlocal Agreement with the City of Carrollton.
- The estimated annual amount paid to the City of Carrollton for five (5) SRO's and one (1) SRO Sergeant in 2024/2025 is \$575,000 but will not exceed the approved budget.

Recommendations:

- That the Lewisville ISD Board of Trustees approve the resolution and updated interlocal agreement with the City of Carrollton for School Resource Officers.
