Background Information

The State of Texas requires all law enforcement agencies to collect data related to motor vehicle stops and to have that data analyzed annually to determine whether the agency is engaging in racial profiling. State law further requires that the results of this analysis be presented to the agency's governing body no later than March 1 of each year.

The comprehensive data analysis presented in this report serves as documented evidence that the Duncanville ISD Police Department is in full compliance with the Texas Racial Profiling Law and all associated statutory requirements. Specifically, the report demonstrates that the department has implemented and maintains a comprehensive racial profiling policy consistent with state law; established and publicized procedures for members of the public to submit compliments or complaints regarding officer conduct; commissioned periodic audits to ensure the validity and reliability of collected data; collected and subjected all required Tier 2 data elements to independent analysis; and clearly prohibited the practice of racial profiling within the organization.

The Duncanville ISD Police Department remains committed to constitutional policing, equitable treatment of all individuals, and continued compliance with all applicable state and federal requirements related to racial profiling prevention and reporting.
