1. Professional Development at Ozona Elementary School.
 - Grade Level Meetings to discuss our results from our Mock Test. Discussions included the following topics: adjustments to tutorial and RTI groups; reading teachers will focus on: context clues, comprehension, vocabulary and fluency; and, additional math instruction and RTI math allotments added in grades 3rd thru 5th.
 - Tutorials: Monday thru Thursday for students in Grades 2nd thru 5th. Students get a snack before/during tutorials. Thanks to the Ozona Women's League!
 - Our teachers had parent conferences with parents/guardians on January 30th. Third grade had 38 out of 71 parents, Fourth grade had 31 out of 59 parents, and Fifth grade had 44 out of 63 parents attend. Our teachers discussed the results from the Mock Test, provided parents with a copy of the STAAR Released Test and a copy of School Report Card. We are scheduling the remaining conferences with parents during teacher conferences. Thank you to Patty Villarreal, Yvette Martinez and Judy Tijerina for scheduling the conferences.
 - Mr. Byrd visited our campus on January 30th and worked with Ms. Parker and myself to desegregate our Mock Test scores and track student progress in reading and math. We looked at all our sources of data including the TPRI, AR Renaissance, AIMSweb, DMAC and Istation. Ms. Parker created some tables in order to look at subgroups' individual growth. We concluded that next year we need to use one or two programs for assessment and progress monitoring grades Kindergarten thru 5th.
2. Our Parent Preview Night occurred on January 16th with a Make-and-Take and Fruit Fair in the cafeteria. Our parent involvement percentage declined to 20% with 90 parents attending.
