## BACKGROUND INFORMATION

Texas Senate Bill 569, passed in 2025, allows districts to offer more flexible learning models. Opening a virtual/ hybrid program would expand access and provide families with more choices while maintaining the quality education families expect from Argyle ISD. This programming option would be available only to high school students. School districts receive the same funding for students in virtual, hybrid, or in-person classes.
