

I recommend approving the 2014-15 Fee Schedule:

The Federal Healthy, Hunger-Free Kids Act, PL 111-296 was enacted in 2010. The legislation authorizes funding and sets policy for The USDA National School Lunch Program. Additional federal funding helps to offset the cost of additional nutritional requirements. However, a minimum local share is also required. Public schools are required to calculate the weighted average meal price annually, and increase by \$0.10 per meal until reaching the federal requirement, which is currently \$2.65 per meal.

The 2014 legislature provided funds to supplement the school's federal revenue for "reduced price" lunches. Accordingly, students who qualify for reduced price lunches receive them free of charge.
