

Resolution

The Board of Trustees of the Tupelo Public School District gave consideration to the matter of selling the deep fat fryers from several school sites that are not longer being used in the district. After a discussion of the subject _____ offered and moved for the adoption of the following resolution.

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees of the Tupelo Public School District of Lee County, Mississippi, (the "Board" of the "District"), hereby finds, determines, adjudicates and declares as follows:

1. The Board, as authorized and empowered by the provisions of Sections 37-7-451, and 37-7-455, Mississippi Code Annotated, declares the items indicated as obsolete, unnecessary, and of no value for educational purposes.
2. The Board authorizes the Finance Department to sell the said deep fat fryers as set forth in MS Code Annotated, 31-7-13, M, vi.
3. As set forth in Section 37-7-457, Mississippi Code (Ann.) proceeds of such sale shall be placed in the Tupelo School Food Service funds.
