Summer School – We are in the process of organizing summer school courses and contracting teachers. This summer we have a few teachers at the Middle School who are hoping to offer courses to incoming 6-8 grade students. We are currently in need of teachers willing to teach incoming 5K – incoming 2nd grade courses.
