SCC All-Conference boys track team members: Adam Miller – high jump and 300 M hurdles. Adam also qualified for the IHSA State Meet in these events.

SCC All-Conference girls track team members: Claudia Magnussen (1600 M Run, 3200 M Run); Shayna Stremming (triple jump); Katelin Weideman, Sydney Maton, Aubrey Beyers, Daylee Denton (4 X 100 M Relay).

Claudia, 4 X 100 M Relay team, Daylee Denton & Colleen Weddle (both long jump), Colleen Weddle (400 M Run) and the 4 X 200 Relay (Katelin Weideman, Breanna Rochkes, Aubrey Beyers, Daylee Denton), Madison Hilbert (pole vault) all qualified for the IHSA State Meet. Claudia broke her own school records in the 1600 M Run (5:09.66) and 3200 M Run (11:09.71) and placed 3rd in both races at the State Meet. The 4 X 100 M Relay team broke the school record with a time of 50.67 and placed 8th at the State Meet. Daylee placed 5th in the long jump with a 16' 11 ¾" jump (just ¼" shy of the school record). As a team, the girls finished with 21 points, good enough for 12th Place overall!

Freshman Orientation will be Tuesday, August 16. Bonnie Sowarsh, freshman counselor, is organizing another half-day event.

Also included the following stipulations: leggings, jeggings, yoga pants are prohibited; the length of shorts, skirts and dresses must be knee length; clothing with holes, rips, tears, and clothing that is otherwise poorly fitting, showing skin and/or undergarments may not be worn at school.
- Pg. 10 Section XVIII. Graduation Requirements. Added this statement:
Students with excessive absences as defined on page 4, section VI, part B, [one-fourth of the school year (45 days)] may not be allowed to participate in the graduation ceremony.
- Pg. 20 Removed the following language under section titled “Saturday Detention.”
Failure to serve a Saturday detention will result in an automatic two (2) or more day out-of-school suspension.
- Pgs. 22-25 Updated entire Prohibited Student Conduct section in accordance with the Illinois School Code.
- Pgs. 25-26 Updated entire Disciplinary Actions section in accordance with the Illinois School Code.
- Pg. 26 Added section: Re-Engagement of Returning Students in accordance with the Illinois School Code.
