ENRICHMENT PROGRAM

As a part of the 21st Century Grant, Afterschool Centers on Education (ACE) programs will be offered during the month of June at the following campuses:

- Levelland Academic Beginnings Center
- Levelland Middle School (for Levelland Intermediate School, too)
- Levelland High School

Each campus will provide specific information about their summer offerings outside of the programs listed above. This will include dates, times and meeting locations.

CAMPUSES:

The Extended Year and STAAR Preparation/Remediation Program for grades 1-3 will be held at Capitol Elementary. Kindergarten will meet at Levelland Academic Beginnings Center.

The Extended Year and STAAR Preparation/Remediation Program for grades 4-8 will be held at Levelland Middle School

The Bilingual program for grades PK-K will be held at Capitol Elementary.

The High School STAAR/TAKS Remediation and Enrichment Programs for students in grades 9-12 will be held at the High School

The Migrant Program for grades PK-12 will be held at Capitol Elementary.

TIME SCHEDULES:

All classes will start at 8 am. Breakfast will be served from 7:30 a.m. until 8:00 a.m. at Capitol and Middle School. Lunch will be served from 12:00 noon until 12:30 p.m. Bilingual classes at Capitol will meet Monday thru Friday 8:00 a.m. until 12:00 noon with an afternoon session from 12:30 p.m. until 3:30 p.m. every day. The programs at High School will meet Monday through Friday 8:00 a.m. until 12:00 p.m. Students attending the Migrant program will be notified with regard to time schedules.

TRANSPORTATION:

Transportation will be provided for eligible students in grades PK-8. Buses will stop at selected sites within the city.

STAFFING:

Teachers and teacher assistants working in the Summer School Program will be compensated on a daily rate basis. Summer School Principals will be responsible for hiring their staffs. Staff members who have previously worked in Summer School and are highly qualified and work in corresponding grades will be considered first. No Summer School employee will be allowed to miss more than one day because of staff development unless permission is granted by the Summer School Principal.

ELIGIBILITY:

Students to be served in the program are those who are identified as needing supplemental assistance in order to be successful at the next grade level. Others eligible include those who have not passed core subjects and/or who have not been successful on the STAAR. A list of students must be maintained at each campus along with the academic criteria used for determining eligibility.

SUBSTITUTES:

All personnel who are absent will be responsible for hiring their substitutes. Those personnel who are unable to find a substitute will be "docked" on their summer school check.

TRANSFER STUDENTS

Students currently not enrolled in Levelland ISD must present a letter from their sending school to the principal of the school they wish to attend indicating that they must attend summer school in order to be promoted to the next grade. A fee of \$100 will be assessed these students. Acceptance into the program is not guaranteed.
