<b>NWEA/Map Data Highlights</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>- Still some concerns with type of reporting in Math, working with NWEA on making it more clear for our teachers given our schedule and standards based Math program.</li><li>- See attached</li></ul>

### Advisory

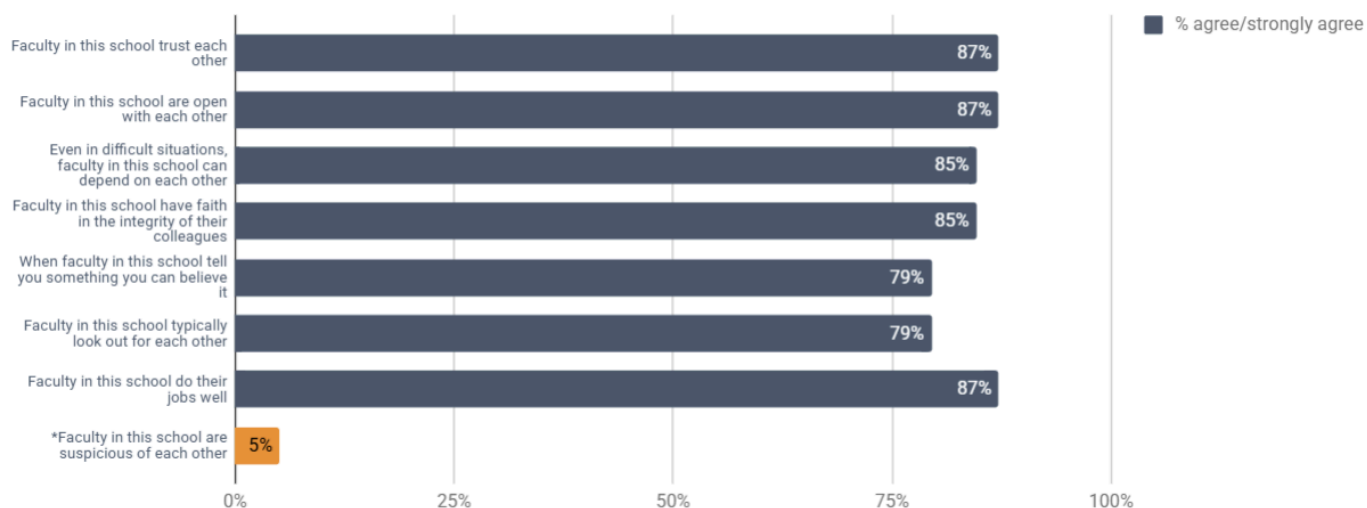

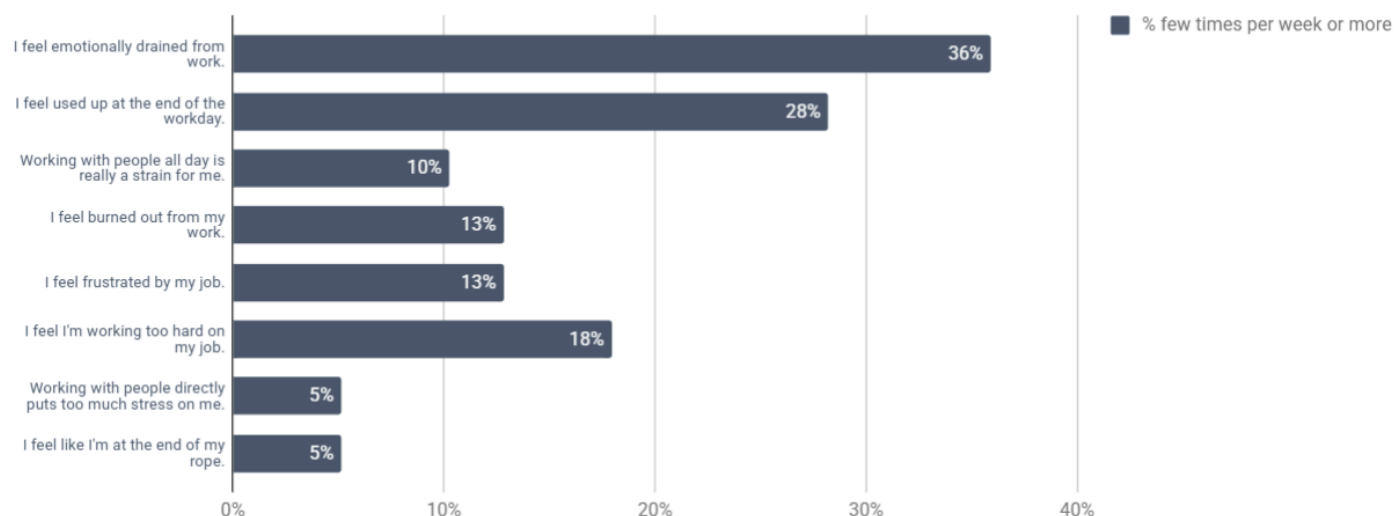

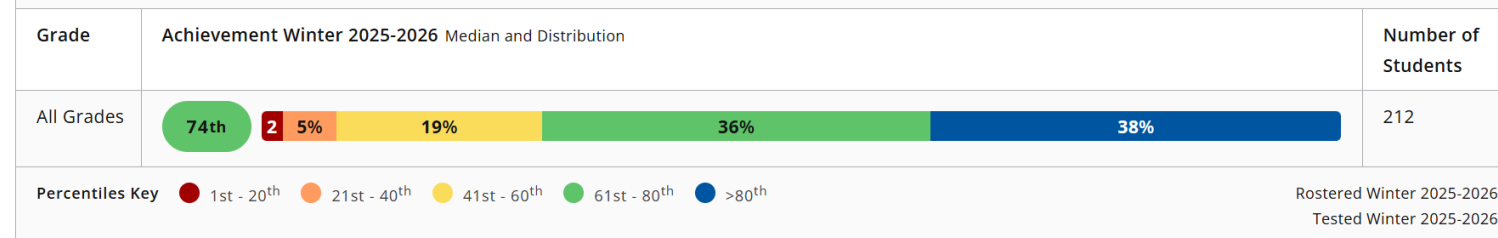

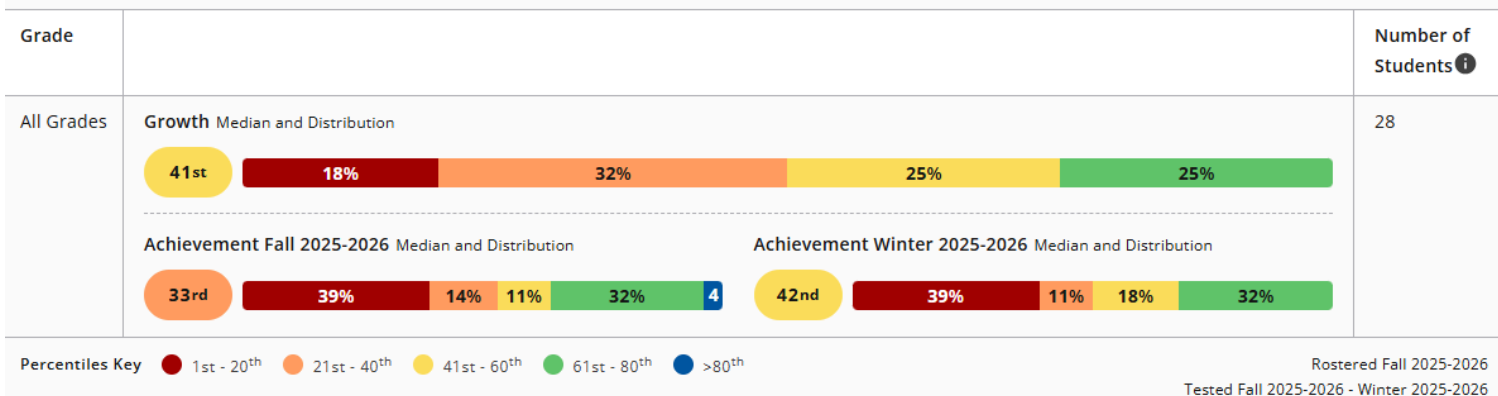


## Algebra 1a Fall 2025:
