



Executive Director Board Report

July 26, 2022

- We have hosted ESY and Compensatory Education for the past 2 weeks for ALEX and SUN students. It has been delightful to see so many students back in the building!
- Staffing continues for our 2022-2023 school year. The current unemployment rate in Rice County and the state are at historic lows. Staffing for open EA positions is challenging.
- We have reached a tentative agreement with non-licensed staff and upon their vote and ratification, we will bring the agreement forward to the Board for consideration.
- Intake meetings continue for new CVSEC students. We are projecting approximately 90 students for the beginning of the school year.
- Mid-July we had 20 new staff members and 18 returning staff members complete Life Space Crisis Intervention training. ALEX will be going into its second year of the trauma-informed model and SUN will be going into year one. ALEX is adding the Performance Tracking System (PTS) for September 2022. Additional staff members from CVSEC will be attending Life Space Crisis Intervention at OPS in mid-August.
- Maintenance and general upkeep continue during the summer. The playground is tentatively planned for installation next week and our magnetic locking door system is tentatively planned for mid to late September.
