TOPIC: **Approval of District Door Access Project**

RECOMMENDATION:

Move that the Board of Education of the Livonia Public Schools School District approves the recommendation from its Owner's Representative, Plante Moran Realpoint and its Technology Consultant, IDS, to purchase new door access and security upgrades equipment from Sequoia Technologies, Rochester Hills, Michigan in an amount not to exceed \$2,371,994, including contingency.

RATIONALE:

This purchase of the door access and alarm system that integrate alarm monitoring, cameras, and centralized management into a single platform will reduce false alarms and after-hours responses. This investment replaces obsolete technology with a modern, efficient, and sustainable security solution that strengthens building safety while reducing long-term operational burden on staff.
