#### Wisconsin Forward Exam and STAR testing

We completed our final round of testing for our students. Through the use of standards based learning, many students have shown growth in many different areas. The Frederic Elementary team looks forward to getting the results of our Wisconsin Forward exam to see if that growth carried over into state testing.

#### <u>Mya the Therapy Dog</u>
