BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

- The instructional data dashboard will provide the district with a systematic process for gathering multiple data points to track implementation levels of the district focus areas and to monitor student progress data throughout the school year.
- During the 2019-2020 school year, AISD will work toward becoming a highfunctioning Professional Learning Community (PLC) through engaging in PLC actions at each campus in order to ensure that all students learn at high levels.
- A Professional Learning Community (PLC) is an ongoing process in which educators work collaboratively in recurring cycles of collective inquiry and action research to achieve better results for the students they serve.
- The three big ideas that drive the work of the PLC process include:
 - Learning as our Fundamental Purpose
 - Building a Collaborative Culture Through High-Performing Teams
 - A focus on Results
- At the campus and district level, PLC actions will be monitored and rated at the
 end of each grading cycle on an implementation continuum that corresponds to
 the three big ideas of a PLC. Data will be collected and analyzed in order to
 assess team and district level implementation of the three big ideas throughout
 the school year.
