

Superintendent Goals 2013 – 2014

A true educational leader accomplishes nothing alone. The following goals describe the work comprised of educational leaders in the Beaverton School District, teachers and community members working cohesively with one another.

1. Individual Student Growth:

Every student in our schools deserves the attention and support necessary to make progress toward their academic goals. For every Beaverton student to be prepared for college and/or a career, we will focus on skills aligned to our student-centered goal (Think, Know, Act, Go).

As Superintendent I will:

- As part of the Board Student Achievement Subcommittee, produce a system for measuring student achievement that is aligned to our Strategic Plan, student goals and Pillars of Learning.
- Report to the Board and community the programs and initiatives that have an impact on instruction and student learning. I will produce three written updates, (November, February and June) specific to district-wide successes, challenges and future efforts to deliver gains in student achievement.

2. Advocacy & Funding

The Beaverton School District has a responsibility to advocate locally, statewide and nationally to fund education at the level our students deserve. Our community should have a voice and support the manner in which we organize and financially structure our schools.

As Superintendent I will:

- Ensure a budget process that demonstrates alignment to:
 - Strategic Plan
 - Board and Community Priorities
- Facilitate, delegate and support a successful local school bond in May 2014
- As the co-chair to the state superintendent's Vision & Policy Task Force, produce a statewide vision and a corresponding budget (two year goal).

3. Strategic Plan Engagement, Communication and Implementation

Successful organizations have vision and corresponding structures and systems of implementation.

As Superintendent I will:

- Communicate on-going district best practices throughout the community as we work toward a shared understanding of our Pillars of Learning
- Create a district-wide system to identify exemplary practices and celebrate exemplary work throughout all of our schools that correspond to our vision
- Create a plan and process that engages community stakeholders throughout our schools according to the intent of our Community Engagement Policy
- Increase our public's perception of the district, specific to communication and organizational focus
