Temple High School Cafeteria Equipment and Serving Lines - Vendor Awards

Background Information

As part of the voter-approved 2022 Bond Program, Temple ISD is completing renovations and upgrades to the Temple High School cafeteria to support the District's School Nutrition Program. The project includes modernization of kitchen operations, replacement of aging equipment, improved food preparation capabilities, and enhanced serving capacity to better accommodate student enrollment and meal service efficiency.

The District solicited competitive proposals for cafeteria equipment, serving lines, and walk-in refrigeration/freezer systems for the Temple High School cafeteria project. Proposals were evaluated based on criteria established in the solicitation, including compliance with specifications, overall value to the District, vendor experience, installation services, and long-term operational benefits.

Following evaluation of the submitted proposals, District administration recommends awarding the cafeteria equipment package and six (6) serving lines to Mission Restaurant Supply in the amount of \$1,421,413.81 and awarding the walk-in cooler/freezer package to PASCO Brokerage Inc. in the amount of \$264,586.00 based on the best overall value and responsiveness to District requirements. All equipment is scheduled to install in October of 2026.

Administration Recommendation

It is recommended that the Board of Trustees approve the purchase of Temple High School cafeteria equipment and six (6) serving lines from Mission Restaurant Supply in the amount of \$1,421,413.81 and the walk-in cooler/freezer package from PASCO Brokerage Inc. in the amount of \$264,586.00 for the Temple High School cafeteria renovation project funded through School Nutrition Account 240.
