

Annual Goal 1

- To achieve a "Met Standard" rating on each index of the state accountability system and/or
 - To achieve 80% of all students, 75% of economically disadvantaged students, and 70% of Hispanic students meeting the "Phase in 1 Level II" mastery level in the reading, writing, math, and science subject areas with 10% improvement shown in the percentage of all students meeting the Level III Advanced standard as determined by state mandated tests administered at the 3rd, 4th, and 5th grade level and
 - To achieve 80% of all K-2 students and 70% of Hispanic K-2 students reading at the District's expectations as denoted on the ELI and SELI assessments from the beginning of the year to the end of the year

















Annual Goal 2


Strategy


- Improve the school climate:

 - 2) By providing staff with additional support and encouragement for their efforts in creating a supportive learning environment that addresses the needs of all students within their classrooms.














