Pedestrians or crossing guards simply push the button and the light begins flashing for a predetermined amount of time. This particular location shows signing for a pedestrian crossing. The one at Northwinds would be signed as a "School Crossing". This particular flasher is also hard wired for electricity Technology has advanced such, that solar powered flashers are now being used more often in Minnesota.
