DESCRIPTION:

Although students are not in session next Wednesday, October 16th, the teachers are! For the past five years, this day prior to fall break has been designated as a district staff development day. For several years, a district planning team has organized and orchestrated a day for learning about technology -- technology tools and technology integration.
