

Executive Summary: ISBE School Maintenance Project Grant – SVHS Storefront Replacement

The Administration is requesting Board of Education approval to submit an ISBE School Maintenance Project Grant application for the complete replacement of the Stillman Valley High School storefront, including both exterior and interior components.

The existing storefront has reached the end of its useful life and presents concerns related to energy efficiency, weather integrity, and building security. Replacing the storefront will improve safety, durability, and overall building performance while supporting the district's ongoing facility maintenance efforts.

The estimated project cost is \$125,000. Administration is seeking approval for a do-not-exceed amount of \$125,000, contingent upon final bids and ISBE grant approval. Required local matching funds will be reserved, and no work will begin until ISBE authorization is obtained.

Recommendation

I recommend the Board of Education consider the approval of a do not exceed \$125,000 for the SVHS storefront replacement under the ISBE School Maintenance Project Grant.
