

Goal 1: Kinder Readiness

Prepare preschool students with the social/emotional, motor, cognitive and language/literacy skills needed to succeed in kindergarten.

- **Provide ½ day preschool** to all children ages 3, 4, and 5 years old.
- Provide high-quality early learning experiences.
- Utilize research-based instructional resources and strategies focusing on developmentally appropriate practices and intentional instruction.
- Implement culturally relevant, place-based learning opportunities to support whole child development and a sense of connectedness within their community.



Goal 6: CQIP

Bolster continuous quality improvement efforts across early learning programs with the intent to provide high-quality early learning experiences.

- Participate in the State's Quality Rating & Improvement System (QRIS)
- Implementation of Pyramid Model
- Alaska Learn & Grow to further develop the following components within our Early Learning Programs:
 - Administration & Leadership
 - EC Educator Qualifications & P.D.
 - Learning Environment, Adult-Child Interactions & Child Outcomes
 - Family & Community Partnerships



Goal 2: Expand SEL Supports

Provide wellness and mindfulness resources throughout the year to develop social & emotional awareness for both educators and students.

- Implement The Pyramid Model:
 Promoting social emotional learning in young children to enhance the classroom environment and foster positive adult-child interactions.
- Facilitate weekly, virtual SEL Lessons ("Mindful Mondays" & "Thoughtful Thursdays") that include literacy-based lessons, connecting mindfulness & movement activities to an engaging read-aloud experience, while supporting culturally relevant, place-based practices.
- Provide PBIS: (positive behavior intervention & support) through family partnerships to provide appropriate, responsive support for overall student development.

Goal 4: Enhanced PD

Provide a tiered system of support that includes PD for both the EC Director and EC Educators to continue building system-wide capacity.

- PD Opportunities: Monthly PLC
 meetings, district-wide in-service
 sessions, state-wide meetings, onsite & virtual coaching cycles,
 opportunity to attend the regional
 early learning conference, &
 asynchronous courses/modules.
- **Design PD** for effective implementation & integration of evidence-based resources.
- **PD Checklist** to track & document PD completion throughout the year.
- End of Year Survey to monitor ongoing support & implement responsive program enhancements.
- Performance Pay to provide compensation commensurate with EC Educator time, effort, and dedication to professional growth.

Goal 3: Amplify Instruction

Prepare preschool students with the social/emotional, motor, cognitive and language/literacy skills needed to succeed in kindergarten.

- Implement Teaching Strategies GOLD, documentation provided 3 times each year. (Nov. Feb. May)
- Implement Big Day for PreK, a comprehensive program that covers all domains of early learning & development.
- Implement Heggerty- Phonological Awareness: Supplementary early literacy curriculum.
- Develop additional classroom & family resources with embedded foundations of early childhood SOR principles and evidence-based best practices. (Literacy Board Games, Event Facilitator Guides, Summer Learning Materials)

Goal 5: Family Engagement

Foster positive, collaborative family engagement opportunities (individually & group settings) while honoring and valuing families contributions.

- Facilitate regular, meaningful communication with families.
- Host family engagement events.
- Provide take-home resources & materials (BRIDGE Bags, Literacy Kits, Focused Learning Activities)
- Implement **Kindergarten Transition** Plans to support a child's next steps.
- Share an **End of Year Survey** to gather feedback on program effectiveness & to support quality systems of improvement.
