- 3) Hidden Valley High School Future Business Leaders of America is requesting continued board support of our National competition by granting permission to travel to Anaheim, CA. for the FBLA National Leadership Conference, June 24 through July 3rd, and approval of \$300 per student to help offset travel costs. Students, chaperones and Adviser (Chris Pendleton) will be attending at the end of June to the beginning of July.
- 3A) Plans for the Summer Trip: A two-day bus trip down to Anaheim with a stop in San Francisco and Santa Cruz to visit the sites before arriving in Anaheim.
