AR 9311 BOARD POLICIES (First Read)

Regular Policy Review

To ensure that policies are updated to meet changing conditions and legal requirements, all policies will be subject to regular review and revision. Prior to revisions being adopted, policies shall normally be given two readings by the Board. At its second reading, the policy may be adopted by a majority vote of members of the Board. The Board may waive the second reading, <u>including but not limited to, when circumstances or situations exist, such as alignment to or compliance with state or federal law. The Board may also or may require additional readings before adoption, as the it deems necessary.</u>

The District considers the following components or "look-fors" within the context of policy review:

- 1. Ensuring that options found in existing or model policies are chosen (Option 1 or Option 2);
- 2. Policy implementation considerations (resources, practicality);
- 3. Consistency among policy references and terms; and
- 4. Practice vs. policy considerations (i.e. Do they match?)

The review cycle below was revised and approved by the School Board in April 2017 (Year 0).
