Recommendations:

Administration is recommending approval to use Competitive Seal Proposal (CSP) as the Method of Procurement for construction of a new Food Production Center facility for the Child Nutrition Dept.

Rationale:

As per Government Code 2269.056, the Board of Trustees of a public school district that is considering a **construction** contract using a method other than competitive bidding, must, before advertising, determine which method provides the best value. Request for Competitive Sealed Proposals (CSP) is the procurement method best suited for projects that are not schedule-sensitive nor subject to potential change. Some advantages of this method are the selection flexibility and the open aggressive bidding it provides. In reviewing the scope of the recommended project, Administration has determined that CSP is the best value method for this project.
