TASB Policy Update 91

Purpose of Report

Update 91 contains 99 legal policies, 6 local policies and 4 exhibits of which 3 local policies will be deleted. Update 91 represents the <u>first of three</u> post-legislative updates and encompasses changes in law from the 82nd Legislative Session that have an immediate effect on the governance and management of the district. Update 91 addresses a variety of major topics, including elections, purchasing and construction contracts, investments, instructional materials, employee contracts, student truancy and discipline, student concussions, and district records. Also included in Update 91 are local policies that address nonrenewal of employee contracts, facilities construction, investments, corporal punishment, dating violence, and instructional materials.
