FISCAL NOTE: Bond Funds

Background Information:

 A CFA (Community Facilities Agreement) is a document required by the City of Fort Worth to bind the development of a new site (Keller ISD) with required public improvements. This includes water, sewer, drainage and road improvements. The City of Fort Worth separates these improvements into two CFA's; a water/sewer CFA, and a roads/drainage CFA.

Administrative Considerations:

- The CFA's for high school #4 include:
 - <u>Roads/Drainage</u>: This includes an onsite loop drive and storm drainage for the entire site. Our cost is \$1,218,728.
 - <u>Water/sewer</u>: This includes extension of sanitary sewer to our new facilities as well as all onsite water for both fire loop and domestic water. Our cost is \$274,098.

The administration recommends that the Board of Trustees enter into a Community Facilities Agreement with the City of Fort Worth for roads / drainage and water / sewer for new high school #4.
