- Building is 10,864 square feet (includes office space, textbooks, records)
- Instructional materials ship May September
- Floor space is required for processing materials
 - Pallets are stacked according to content and grade
- A minimum of 4 work hours are necessary for moving products to the parking lot for processing
- Products are delivered to campuses by content after processing
- During a non-adoption year, approximately 500 pallets are processed
- 2018-2019 adoption of K-8 English Language Arts Reading, Spelling, Handwriting, and Spanish Language Arts will require approximately 5,500 pallets to be processed (includes teacher and student materials)

- 15 Five drawer filing cabinets




















