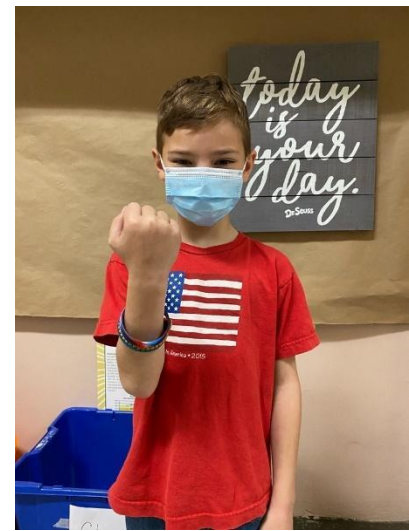


Earth Day was Thursday April 22! Look at our BEAUTIFUL campus!
