One of the titles, *The Mangrove Tree: Planting Trees to Feed Families* by Susan L. Roth and Cindy Trumbore (for K-5 schools) won the 2012 Jane Addams Peace Award for younger children and the second book, *Sylvia & Aki* by Winifred Conkling (for 6-8 schools) won the 2012 award for older children. The *Mangrove Tree* is a true story about a scientist who helped the people of Hargigo, Eritrea to plant trees that would feed them and their animals. *Sylvia & Aki* is based on a true story of a Mexican girl who was not allowed to enroll at the public school and Aki's family who was sent to an internment camp in California. The girls are friends to this day.

Ms. Chrisman hopes to donate books from the Jane Addams Peace Award list to the Oak park Schools annually.
