



CPI-U Comparison 2024* vs. 2025*



Revenues Year to Date: September 2025



 - Upgraded to Verkada System
- Junior High is on Wisenet
 - Cameras are aging
 - "Meal Piecing" replacements cameras as they fail
 - On Premise server is at end of life
- Junior High Vape Sensors already tied to Verkada



- Met with 3 different vendors:
 - Heartland Business Systems
 - Seconds Matter Safety Solutions
 - Heart Technologies
- Each walked with IT/Administrators to review current layout, offer recommendations, and ensure "blind spots" were addressed
- Heartland had the best pricing
- Project funding included in FY26 Budget






VERKADA


- Cloud-based system
 - No longer need to upgrade costly on premise servers
 - Easy access to footage
- Added cameras for needed coverage outside (athletic fields)
- Higher megapixel cameras with "built-in" Al analytics
- Licensing to match renewals with other buildings
 - Renewal due in Spring of FY28

 - Retrieve footage through search
 - Alerts:
