Responsible Use of Technology

The Board believes access to technology should be equitable for all students, differentiated to meet varied student needs, and utilized and promoted in a manner that enhances academic achievement. The Board shall guide the responsible use of technology, including, but not limited to, generative artificial intelligence and other technologies, and shall outline best practices for technology use. The Board encourages staff to responsibly integrate technology into instruction in a manner that promotes student engagement, future readiness, innovation, expanded learning opportunities, and adheres to research-based best practices.

The Board authorizes the superintendent to develop and implement administrative regulations governing how and when technology use is allowed or disallowed. Such procedures will protect appropriate staff and student use of technology and encourage equitable opportunities for learning about and experiencing technology.
