

# SUPPORT FLEET SYNOPSIS | Alpena County

## THE SITUATION

## Current light duty fleet age is negatively impacting the overall budget and fleet operations

- 50% of the light duty fleet is currently 10 years or older
- **50%** of the fleet has over 90,000 miles on the odometer
- 11 years is the current average age of the fleet
- 22 years time it would take to cycle this entire segment of the organization's fleet at current acquisition rates
- Older vehicles have higher fuel costs, maintenance costs and tend to be unreliable, causing increased downtime and loss of productivity.

## **THE OBJECTIVES**

# Identify an effective vehicle life cycle that maximizes potential equity at time of resale creating a conservative savings of over \$854,031 over 10 years

- Shorten vehicle life cycle from 12.8 years to 3.63 years
- Provide a lower sustainable fleet cost that is predictable year over year
- 70% reduction in repair and maintenance costs
- 14% reduction in fuel spend due to increased fuel efficiency of newer vehicles.
- Leverage an open-ended lease to maximize cash flow opportunities and recognize equity
- Review program on an annual basis to improve plans based on market factors with resale, fuel price, etc.
- Vehicles not subject to mileage or wear penalties.

### **Additional Benefits**

- Improved safety and risk with newer vehicles and up to date safety technology
- Less downtime and more employee productivity

### Enterprise is currently working with the Counties of Grant Traverse, Charlevoix, Emmet, Oceana, and Osceola:

- In 2019 the City of Lansing began their program with 9 ½ Ton GMC trucks with a capitalized price of \$27,500 each. In September 2020 after 16 months in the Enterprise program they were able to cycle the units following our recommendation for an average resale amount of \$34,500.
- A 20% net gain on investment
- In lieu of a monthly operating cost the city recognized an average monthly gain of \$240


# **THE RESULTS**

By partnering with Enterprise Fleet Management, the Alpena County will be better able to leverage its buying power, implement a tighter controlled resale program to lower total cost of ownership and in turn minimize operational spend. Leveraging an open-ended lease maximizes cash flow and recognizes equity from vehicles sold creating an internal replacement fund. Furthermore, the Alpena County will leverage Enterprise Fleet Management's ability to sell vehicles at an average of 111+% above Black Book value. By shifting from reactively replacing inoperable vehicles to proactively planning vehicle purchases, the organization will have a more sustainable and predictable budget moving forward.

# CASE STUDY | LACKAWANNA COUNTY

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# Pennsylvania county replaces vehicles and reduces fleet spend by over \$95,000.

#### BACKGROUND

Location: Scranton, PA Industry: Government Total vehicles: 71 vehicles

#### THE PROBLEM

Prior to partnering with Enterprise Fleet Management, the majority of Lackawanna County's vehicles were approaching ten to thirteen years in service. The aged fleet was causing significant operational inefficiencies and the county's annual fleet budget was being spent on maintenance, repairs and high fuel expenses, leaving little to no money for newer vehicles. County employees were experiencing a lot of downtime which ultimately effected productivity.

#### THE SOLUTION

Eackswanna County partnered with Enterprise Fleet Management to update its vehicles and handle its ongoing fleet needs. The county now benefits from proactive fleet planning with the best vehicle recommendations. Lockswanna County has acquired new vehicles and has reduced overall fleet costs by eliminating unphanned repairs and by lowering fuel costs by running a more that afficient fleet.

Lackawanna County enrolled in Enterprise's maintenance program and uses the budget-friendly, fixed maintenance program to plan ahead for its fleet service expenses. Additionally, the county has been able to capitalize on higher vehicle resale values to apply to its new vehicles; offering the department a lower, sustainable fleet that is predictable year-over-year. 
#### THE RESULTS
